

**READING BERKS JUNIOR SOCCER LEAGUE
PROCEDURE FOR REPORTING SCORES – SPRING 2008**

Report scores and Referee Status for all U9 - U19 Travel & Recreational Divisions.

Please add in the report whether or not a referee was present for the games so accurate records can be kept of no show ref's.

Scores are to be reported to league Statistician via email from the CLUBS Game Commissioner: scores@rbjsl.org.

COACHES: DO NOT report your scores to the league statistician. Coaches are to report scores to their club games commissioner or reporter. Clubs game commissioner or reporter will report all their scores to the league statistician.

Home and Away scores are to be reported to your club reporter. We are using both team reports for accuracy.

The club reporter will be given a format for reporting all the scores for each week.
It will be the reporter's decision weather or not to track down any score that was not reported by their club deadline.

Reporters please do not report a score as a loss if you did not receive the information from a coach.

If a game was cancelled please report that game number to the league statistician so proper records can be kept.

Format to report scores:

1. Notify your club representative of the score and referee status. Your club representative will send the information for all club home games that weekend to the league statistician, Jen Shick.
2. When reporting scores, please follow the following procedure.
 - a. Club name and representative's name
 - b. Division
 - c. Game number – located on left side of schedule
 - d. Home team ID (ex. FLE-071)
 - e. Home team score
 - f. Away team ID (ex. FLE-071)
 - g. Away team score
 - h. Please add if the referee was at your game. This can simply be done with a yes or no following the away team score.

PLEASE BE SURE TO ALWAYS LIST THE HOME TEAM FIRST!!

3. All scores MUST be reported by 9:00 PM Monday evening. If scores are not reported by this time the club will be fined \$25.00 per missing score. The club will be fined a maximum of 3 missing scores per week.
4. The newspaper reserves the right to publish or not publish scores, depending on space availability.
